## Diploma Pharmacy (Two Year Duration)

#### (1) Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate

- a. The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- pass in 10+2 examination (science academic stream) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

OR

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination Note: Other than Maharashtra State Candidates shall be eligible for Institution quota only.

## (2) NRI / OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries, Foreign National. -

pass in 10+2 examination (scienceacademic stream) with Physics, Chemistryand Biology or Mathematics.

OR

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination

#### General Note:

- a. If letter grades are assigned at SSC, HSC, or its equivalent examination, the Candidate must submit the certificate of conversion of letter grades into equivalent marks from the concerned Competent Authority or Board at the time of submission of Application Form. The eligibility shall be decided on the basis of equivalent marks.
- Candidates passing SSC from other than State Boards or Central Boards shall bring equivalent certificate from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE).
- c. Candidate who has secured admission in any other institute shall produce certificate indicating his/ her original Leaving Certificate retained with the previous institute in the form of "proforma" given in the brochure

#### Reservations:

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidatesbelonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) Reservation for Backward Class category Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward classcategories belonging to Maharashtra State is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, coming under the CAP. #### (b) Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five percent (5%) seats of the total seats for Maharashtra candidatescoming under CAP per course shall be reserved for Children of ex- servicepersonnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1), Children ofactive service personnel who are Domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2), Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State, or who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC examination from a school/college situated in the State of Maharashtra.

- These seats are within the sanctioned intake and are available as State Level seats.
- (ii) A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 and DEF3candidates shall be prepared.
- (iii) Candidates claiming these seats shall produce additional documentsinProforma C, D and/or E as applicable.
- (iv) This provision is NOT available to the children of CIVILIAN STAFFwho is working /who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

#### (c) Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidate:

Five percent (5%) seats of total seats for Maharashtra candidates per coursecoming under CAP shall be reserved for Candidates having any of the followingminimum 40% benchmark disability.

Locomotor disability, Intellectual disability, Leprosy cured person, Specific learning disabilities, Cerebral palsy, Autism spectrum disorder, Dwarfism, Mental illness, Muscular dystrophy, Multiple sclerosis, Acid attack victims, Parkinson's disease, Blindness, Haemophilia, Low-vision, Thalassemia, Deaf, Sickle cell disease, Hard of hearing, Multiple Disabilities, Speech and language disability

A single merit list of all eligible candidates shall be prepared. The allotment of seats reserved for the Candidates with Disability shall be done on the basis of an inter-se merit. These seats are available for Maharashtra domiciled candidates in HU / SL seats.

The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit thecertificates from the authority competent for issuing such certificate. Thecertificate (Pro-forma) should clearly state that the extent of disability is notless than 40% (Forty percent) and the disability is permanent in nature.

#### Note: -

Candidates with Disability should note that on admission to degree coursethey will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academicactivities other than those which may be provided by the respectiveUniversities.

#### (d) Reservation for EWS Candidate:

As per the provisions in GovernmentResolution No. -4019/..31/16-, dated 12th February, 2019, 10%seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates.

These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CAP as perthe policies of the Government declared from time to time. These 10% seatsshall be over & above the sanctioned intake for the respective course.

#### (e) Reservations for Orphan Candidates—

One percent (1%) seats of CAP Seats(excluding Minority institutions, All India Seats, if any) shall be reserved for Orphan Candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authoritythrough CAP as per Government Resolution, Women and Child Welfare Department, No. AMJ-2011/C.R. 212 / Desk 3 dated 2nd April 2018 and the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

#### (f) Reservation for female candidates:

As per the provisions in GovernmentResolution No. GEC-1000/ (123/2000)/ Tech. Edu.-1, dated 17th April,2000, 30% seats shall be reserved for female candidates. There shall be noreservation for Female candidates under Defence, Persons with Disabilityand Orphan categories.

# Fees Prescribed

## Cancellation of Admission and Refund of fees, return of documents by Institutions. -

- (a) The Candidate shall apply online for cancellation and submit duly signedcopy of system generated application for cancellation of admission to theinstitution. Once the candidate submits online request for cancellation, his/her admission shall be treated as cancelled. The Institute shall consider the online request made by Candidate for cancellation as final irrespective of whether he/she has submitted duly signed copy of system generated application to the Institute. - a. The scheme/mode of concessions, scheme of loan scholarship (if any) intuition& other fees for eligible candidates, will be announced by theCentral /State Government. These candidates will get only that amount ofwaiver as notified in the circulars issued by the Government Departmentfrom time to time, subject to fulfillment of various norms and conditionslaid down by these Departments.
